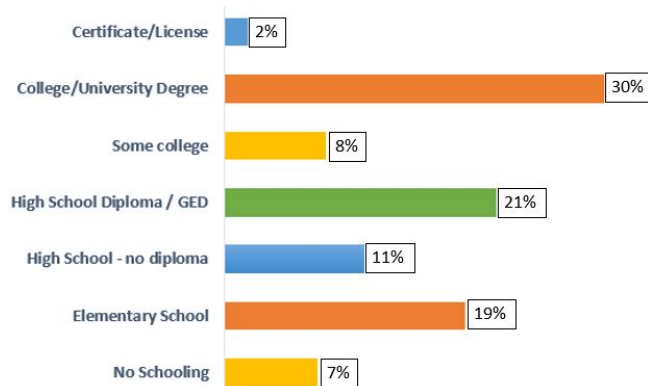
Through direct English language and integrated skills instruction in a classroom setting, we help students develop the tools they need to engage and succeed in our shared communities.

Annual Report FY 2018

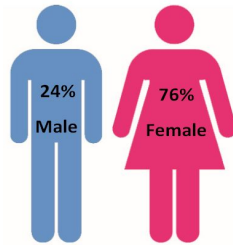
Students

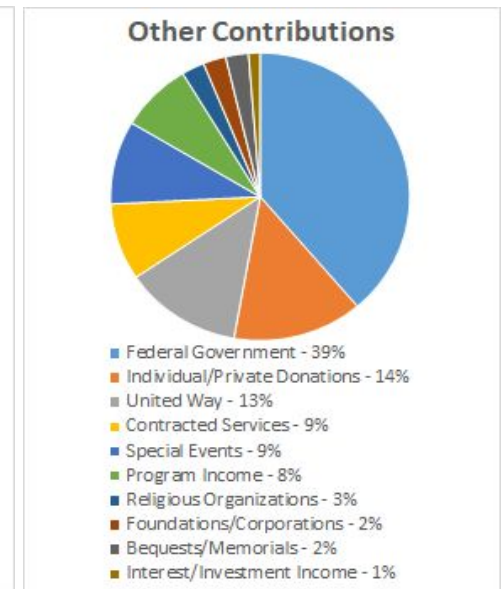
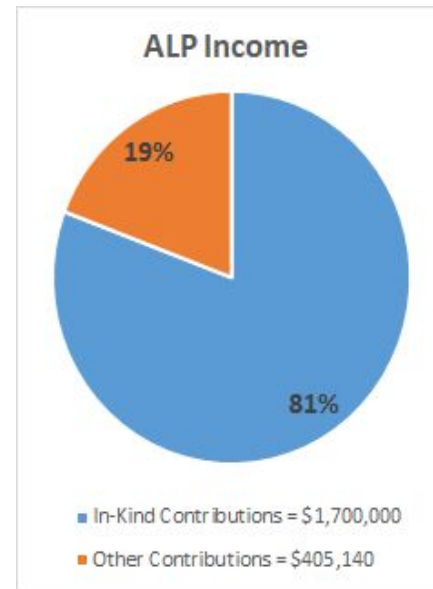
Volunteers
